RE: Stainless Steel Wire Rod from the Republic of Korea: Second Extension of Deadline for Final Results of Circumvention Inquiry

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

On May 18, 2021, North American Stainless (NAS), a domestic producer of stainless steel wire rod, requested that the Department of Commerce (Commerce) initiate circumvention inquiry pursuant to section 781(c) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (the Act), with respect to the antidumping duty order on stainless steel wire rod from the Republic of Korea.<sup>1</sup> The final results of this circumvention inquiry are currently due by April 11, 2023.<sup>2</sup>

However, according to 19 CFR 351.302(b), unless expressly precluded by the statute, Commerce may, for good cause, extend any time limit. Commerce has determined that additional time is necessary to issue the final results of this circumvention inquiry. Therefore, in accordance with 19 CFR 351.302(b), we are extending the deadline for issuing the final results of this circumvention inquiry until May 24, 2023.
